2. **Separate email IDs** for submission of answers will be available on the question paper of each course. **DO NOT** send your answers to any other email ID.
3. The question papers will be available on the Department website, few minutes before the start of the Examination.
4. Kindly refer to the **specific instructions** mentioned on the question papers for each course: the number of questions to be attempted and the email address for submitting answers will be different for each course.
5. Answers must be **hand-written** and the same must be scanned and sent as an email attachment. Kindly make a **single PDF file for each answer**.
6. On the first page of your answer and in the body of the email, kindly mention the following information clearly:
 - i. Your Name
 - ii. Name of Your College
 - iii. Your Roll No. (Mention *Admission Form Number* if roll number is not available)
 - iv. Course Number and Title of Course
 - v. Date of Exam
 - vi. Medium (English/Hindi)
7. The duration of the exams will be **2 hours**. Students will be given **1 hour extra for scanning and attaching** the files, in accordance with the OBE rules of the University. The emails, therefore, must reach the respective email IDs **latest by 5 PM** of each day.
8. People with disability (PwD candidates) will be given 40-minutes extra time, over and above the specified time, in accordance with the University norms.
