The Department of Political Science, University of Delhi, in partnership with the Macmillan Global Justice Program, Yale University & Centre for the Study of Global Ethics at the University of Birmingham, under the *Nyaya* initiative will host a two-day International Workshop on *Law, Institutions and Political Philosophy* August 21-22, 2015.

The workshop Law, Institutions and Political Philosophy aims to provide an enriched understanding of law and its rival perspectives, the institutions that make up the social world in which we live and of the political philosophy that addresses the value and justice of these institutions, both domestic and global. The key speakers at the workshop will address a broad range of research interests with a multi-disciplinary lens to explore linkages between some of the following themes (and debates surrounding them): law, policy, democratic governance, global politics, poverty and inequality, diversity and inclusion, rights, globalization, international law and institutions. The deliberations will seek to draw closer connections between the historical, theoretical, institutional, legal, moral, and policy-making perspectives on some of the central themes covered and hopefully offer a richer understanding of ways to elevate the human condition.
